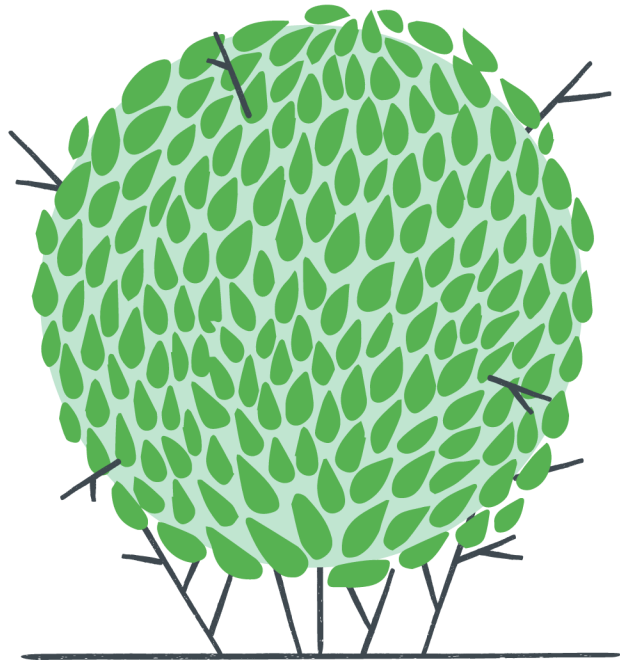

Nouns are names of persons, places, animals/creatures, things and feelings/abstract.

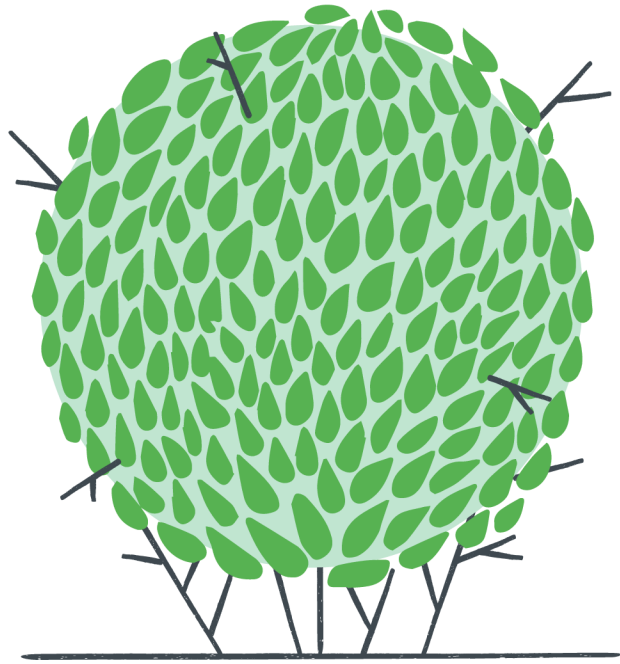
1. **India** is beautiful. - Place

Kinds Of Nouns

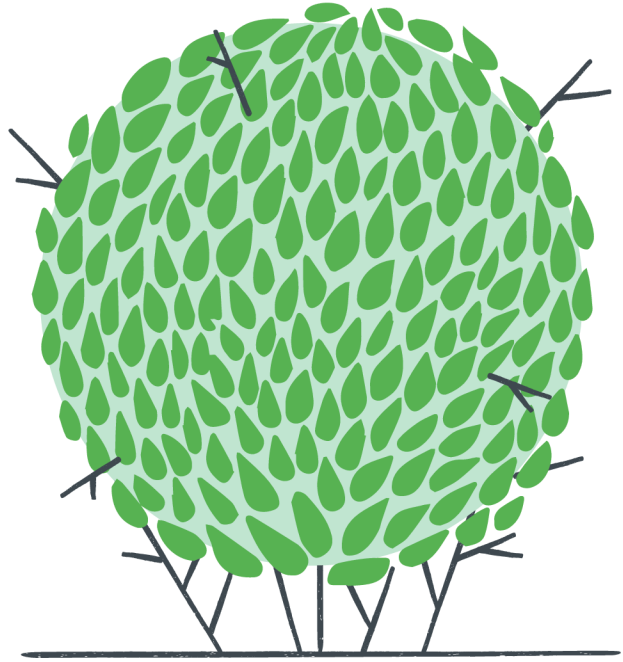
Proper Noun, Common Noun

Collective Noun

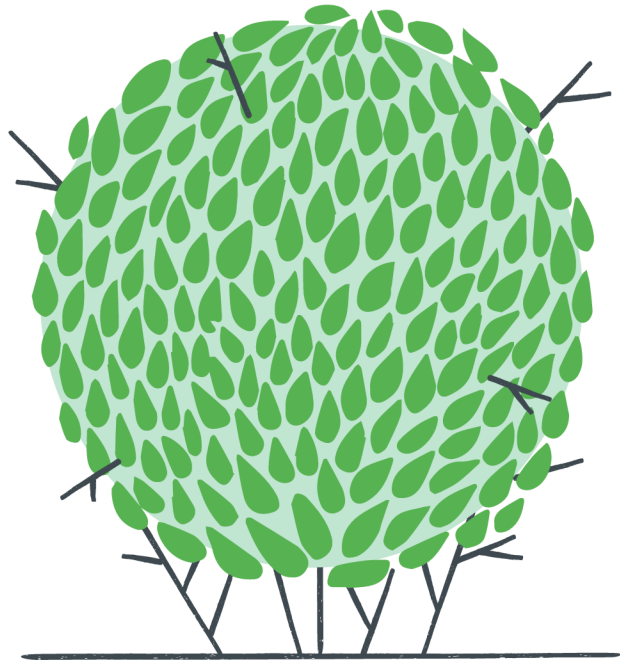
E.g.

Abstract Noun

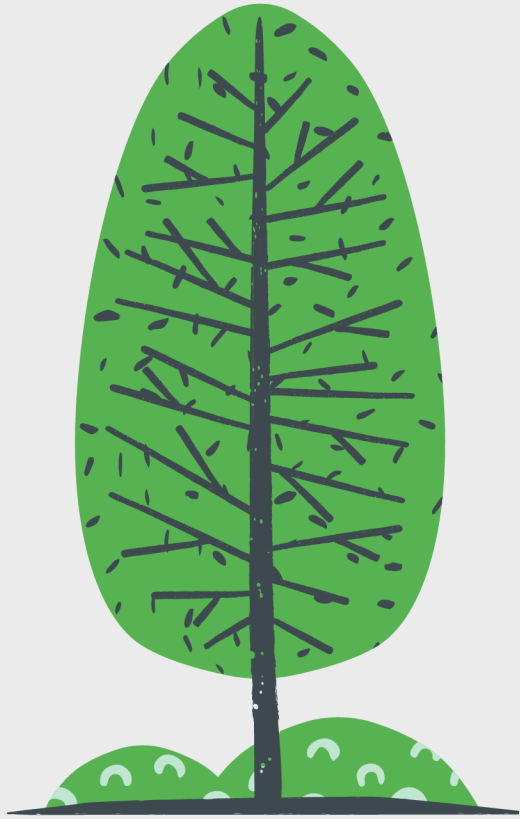
E.g.

The woman lay in **coma**.

Knowledge is valuable.

E.g.

Laugh - **Laughter**

Perform - **Performance**

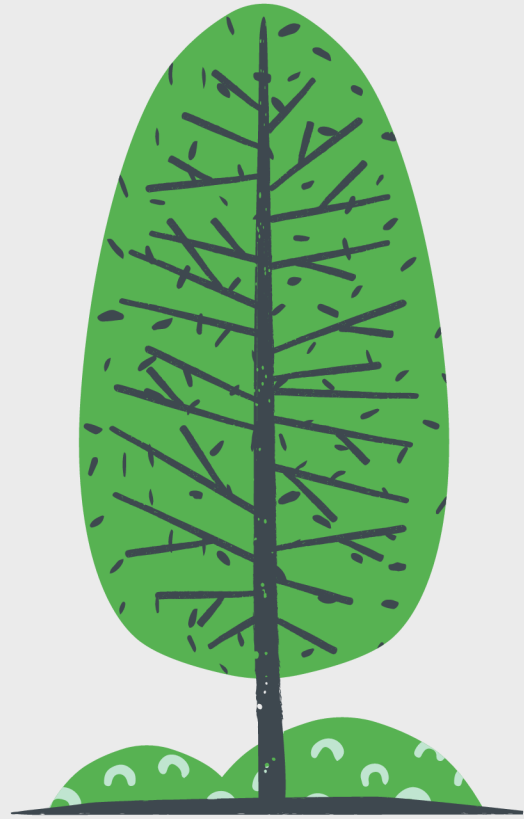
formed with Adjectives

E.g.

Good - **Goodness**

Cruel - **Cruelty**

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Abstract Nouns

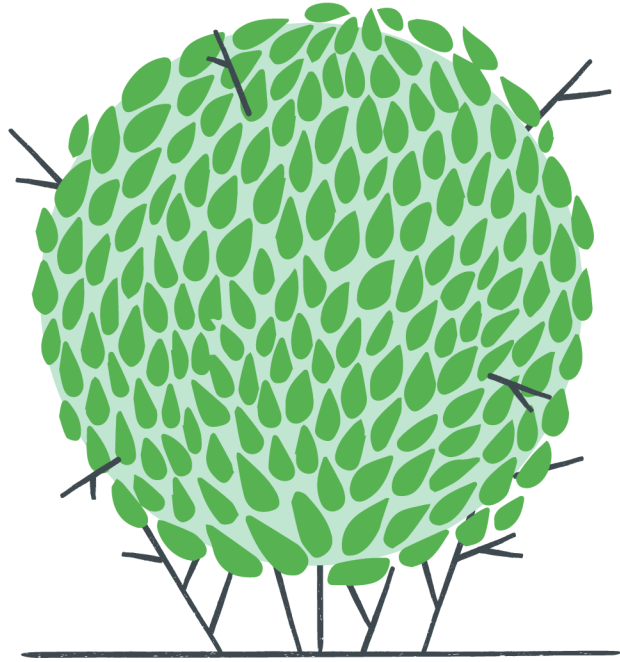
formed with Nouns

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Kinds Of Nouns

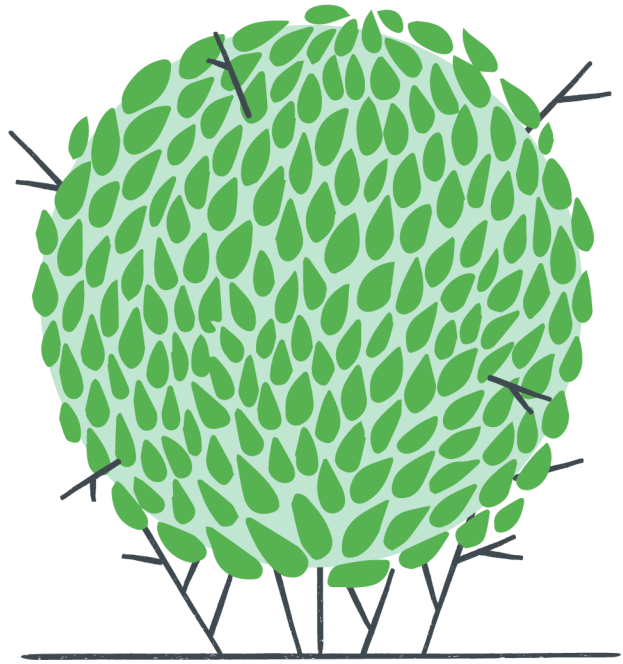
Material Noun
